

Summary Annual Report For Scientific Games Health & Welfare Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the Scientific Games Health and Welfare Plan (Employer Identification Number 81-0422894, Plan Number 501) for the plan year 01/01/2021 through 12/31/2021. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Scientific Games Corporation has committed itself to pay certain medical, dental and FSA claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Vision Service Plan, Prudential Insurance Company of America, Triple S Salud, Inc. And Compsych to pay certain Vision, Life insurance, Temporary disability, Long-term disability, AD&D, Voluntary Life/AD&D, Child/Spouse Life/AD&D, Health, Dental, Prescription drug, PPO contract, Employee Assistance Program claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2021 were \$3,244,786.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2021, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$664,494 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience-rated contracts during the plan year was \$508,754.

This is a summary of the annual report for Scientific Games 1081. 01(d) Plan, EIN 66-0642732, Plan No. 001, for period January 01, 2021 through December 31, 2021. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Banco Popular de Puerto Rico, a regulated financial institution, is the trustee of the qualified plan assets. Plan expenses were \$28,448. These expenses included \$28,448 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 104 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$1,998,768 as of December 31, 2021, compared to \$1,548,589 as of January 01, 2021. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$450,179. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$478,627, including employer contributions of \$71,095, employee contributions of \$134,977, and earnings from investments of \$272,555 .
